



Xi'an — The Cradle of Chinese Civilization, Where Ancient Glory Meets Modern Brilliance

The Eternal Capital of Emperors

Xi'an, historically known as Chang'an, is recognized by UNESCO as a "World Historical City." Alongside Athens, Rome, and Cairo, it is celebrated as one of the "Four Great Ancient Capitals of the World." With a history of over 3,100 years as a city and more than 1,100 years as a capital, it served as the political heart of thirteen dynasties, including the Zhou, Qin, Han, and Tang. It was also the eastern starting point of the ancient Silk Road.


More than just a political, economic, and cultural center of China, Xi'an was a vital hub for the exchange and mutual enrichment of Eastern and Western civilizations, often hailed as the "Spiritual Homeland of Chinese Civilization." Here, history is not merely preserved in museum exhibits but flows through every bluestone brick and echoes in every chime of the morning bell and evening drum, resonating with the vibrant pulse of modern life.

Echoes of History: Drawing Strength from the Cradle of Civilization

When you step onto the land of Xi'an, you step into the "timeline axis" of Chinese civilization. Each relic is a footnote to an era; every brick and stone is inscribed with the code of an ancient culture.

The Terracotta Army of Emperor Qin Shi Huang's Mausoleum – hailed as the "Eighth Wonder of the World" and one of the greatest archaeological discoveries of the 20th century. Over 8,000 life-sized terracotta warriors and horses are arranged in real battle formation, each with distinct expressions and meticulously detailed armor. This grand assembly vividly revives the majestic momentum of the Qin Empire, which "swept across the states and unified the realm." Its monumental scale and exquisite craftsmanship stand as humanity's earliest tribute to order, strength, and collaboration—much like the rhythm, synchronization, and explosive power celebrated in the sport of jump rope.

Hanyangling Mausoleum and the Ruins of Han Chang'an City – Inheriting the Qin's institutional legacy, the Han Dynasty reached the zenith of its national power. The "painted nude figurines" unearthed from Hanyangling Mausoleum vividly portray the daily lives of military and civilians in the Han Dynasty through a realistic artistic style. Meanwhile, the Ruins of Han Chang'an City—once a megacity renowned alongside ancient Rome as "Chang'an in the East, Rome in the West"—though now faded by time, still reveal the grandeur of the Han Empire through its layout of "eight avenues, nine thoroughfares, and twelve city gates."

Big Wild Goose Pagoda and Small Wild Goose Pagoda

Originally built under the direction of the Tang Dynasty monk Xuanzang, was designed to house the 657 Buddhist scriptures and statues he brought back from India. It stands as a vital symbol of Buddhism's eastward transmission and its integration into Chinese culture. With its shadow stretching under the setting sun and its bell echoing through time, the pagoda has witnessed the devout journeys of countless pilgrims and travelers over a millennium. Today, as night falls, musical fountains dance at its base, blending ancient legacy with modern charm.

Not far away, the Small Wild Goose Pagoda narrates a tale of architectural marvel—having withstood over 70 earthquakes without collapse, it stands as a testament to the ingenuity of ancient engineering.



Xi'an City Wall

With origins tracing back to the Sui and Tang dynasties and taking its current form during the Ming Dynasty, the Xi'an City Wall spans 13.74 kilometers, making it the largest and most completely preserved ancient city wall in China. From its broad ramparts, one can cycle or stroll while gazing upon the sweeping eaves and intricate brackets of the Bell and Drum Towers to one side and the soaring skyscrapers of the modern city to the other - a seamless fusion of history and the present.

Much like jump rope, an ancient yet ever-evolving sport, the wall embodies how tradition and innovation can coexist, continually pushing boundaries while honoring the past.

A Cultural Banquet: Flourishing Chang'an, Where Nations Converged

Xi'an is not merely a vessel of history but a crucible of culture. Diverse civilizations once met, clashed, and coexisted here, fostering the openness, inclusiveness, and confidence that defined the glorious Tang era.



Shaanxi History Museum

As China's first large-scale modern national museum built after the Reform and Opening-up, it stands northwest of the Great Wild Goose Pagoda of the Tang Dynasty. Designed by the renowned architect and academician Zhang Jinqiu, the museum follows the Tang-style layout of "central halls flanked by lofty towers at the four corners," creating a structure of majestic solemnity and natural grace.



Its collection comprises over 1.7 million cultural relics, spanning more than a million years—from stone tools used by ancient humans to artifacts witnessing contemporary social life. Among these, 1,600 pieces are classified as National Grade One cultural relics. Here, while a jump rope connects the rhythm of youth, a cultural relic ties us to the roots of our nation—the two converge, together expressing humanity's timeless pursuit of excellence, beauty, and heritage.



The Great Tang All Day Mall

With the culture of the High Tang Dynasty as its soul and modern technology as its wings, the All Day Mall shimmers with dazzling lights at night. Its grand Tang-style architectural complex creates a majestic spectacle, while immersive street performances such as "Li Bai Drunkenly Reciting Poetry" and "Imperial Consort Yang on Parade" transport visitors into a living, breathing Tang-era scene. More than just a tourist landmark, it is a vivid expression of contemporary China's cultural confidence in the glorious legacy of the Tang Dynasty.






Twelve Hours of Chang'an

This attraction meticulously recreates the bustling West Market of the High Tang era, featuring full-scale replicas of taverns, workshops, residences, and opera stages. With over a thousand NPCs dressed in Tang attire roaming the streets and performing scenes like "Zhang Xiaojing Patrolling the Streets" and "Xu Hezi Performing Songs," visitors can dive into the world of ancient Chang'an.

Guests are invited to engage in interactive activities such as arrow throwing, puzzle-solving, Hanfu dress-up, and traditional handicrafts. Enhanced by AR-guided tours and AI-powered photo experiences, the venue also showcases hundreds of intangible cultural heritage items, Tang-style delicacies, and professional Hanfu photography services. Here, visitors transform into "Tang citizens for a day," immersing themselves in the Tang Dynasty and experiencing cultural connection across a thousand years.



Mount Hua: The World's Premier Peak of Wonder and Peril

As the "Western Sacred Mountain" of China's Five Great Peaks, Mount Hua is celebrated as the world's most spectacular and perilous mountain. Its cliffs rise like blades hewn by heaven, with sheer precipices soaring into the clouds.

The ultimate challenge for the brave is the Changkong Plank Path — a dizzying skywalk carved into a vertical cliff face. Here, clouds swirl around the cliffs, and one's heartbeat syncs with the mountain winds. Shaanxi Provincial Gymnasium

The Shaanxi Provincial Gymnasium BE Center is one of the landmark buildings in Xi'an and a top-grade comprehensive sports venue in the city. Constructed for the 14th National Games of China, it can accommodate thousands of spectators and fully meets the requirements for hosting international Class-A sports events.

The gymnasium's design embodies the "Silk Road Ribbon" concept, featuring a silver-toned roof and yellow sandstone elements in its exterior. Equipped with state-of-the-art facilities, it has hosted large-scale international competitions such as basketball, volleyball, and fencing. In 2024, it also served as a venue for the Paris Olympic Women's Basketball Qualifying Tournaments, making it a key platform for cultural and sports activities and a vibrant showcase of Xi'an's modern image.


1. QueenSir International Hotel
